I/We, _____, desire voluntarily to request that _____ perform a circumcision as part of the bris or brit milah ceremony of our son, _____.

I/We further understand and agree that this circumcision is not intended to establish a patient-physician relationship and that it is performed as part of a religious ceremony.

Furthermore, I/we agree to hold harmless _____, his/her heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, from any claims, or causes of action of any kind arising out of any and all known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily or personal injuries, damages to property and consequences thereof which may be sustained in connection with the performance of the circumcision.

I/We understand the nature of a circumcision, that it is the removal of the foreskin using a clamp and then a scalpel or a knife. The risks of circumcision, although uncommon, include pain, trauma, bleeding, infection, poor cosmetic outcome, inadequate circumcision, skin bridging, and rarely mild to severe allergy to the anesthetic used, and/or death.
